MEADOW★STAR INDIVIDUAL SPECIES

BISHOP'S FLOWER *Ammi majus*

Annual; blooms in summer. Large, rounded 5-6" flower heads made up of small snow-white florets. Likes full sun. Will produce blooms the first year; an excellent cut or dried flower. For roadsides, cut flower gardens, disturbed areas.
Seed at 1 kg per acre. Call for \$/kg.

DWARF CORNFLOWER *Centaurea cyanus (Dwarf)*

Annual. Blooms prolifically in summer. Cheerful, ragged blossoms in mixed white, pink, red and blue. Needs little care, resistant to drought and self-sows freely. Prefers full sun. Retain their bright colours when dried! For cutting gardens, roadsides, vacant lots, borders.
Seed at 2 kgs per acre. Call for \$/kg.

TALL CORNFLOWER *Centaurea cyanus (Tall)*

Annual. Blooms in summer. Lovely blue flower that's popular the world over. The fine grey foliage is a beautiful visual element in a bed of perennials with dark foliage. Likes full sun and good drainage. For roadsides, vacant lots, cutting gardens.
Seed at 2 kgs per acre. Call for \$/kg.

WALLFLOWER *Cheiranthus allioni*

Perennial. Vivid orange flowers are 'velvety', 'rich in colour' and delightfully fragrant. Blooms in spring in dense clusters on top of dwarf plants. Great for cool summer coastal or mountainous climates; will also withstand dry conditions once established. For mixtures, roadsides, flower gardens.
Seed at 3 kgs per acre. Call for \$/kg.

PAINTED DAISY *Chrysanthemum carinatum*

Annual. Blooms spring to fall. White, yellow, red or purple with purple center. This brilliant flower provides a dazzling display when mass planted. Makes a long-lasting cut flower. For cutting beds, borders, meadows.
Seed at 4 Kgs per acre. Call for \$/kg.

SHASTA DAISY *Chrysanthemum maximum*

Perennial. Blooms in summer. Large, single flowers, 3-5" wide. 'Classic' white petal with golden yellow centers on erect stems. Prefers full sun to partial shade in fertile soil. An ideal cut flower, lasting up to 10 days in arrangements. Perfect as a ground cover or border plant since foliage is attractive and remains green all year.
Seed at 2.25 Kgs per acre. Call for \$/kg.

SEMI-DWARF GODETIA *Clarkia amoena*

A short annual with four pink-red fan shaped flower petals. Prefers full sun in well drained soils, and once established requires very little moisture. Will bloom prolifically all summer. For roadsides, mixtures, and floral gardens.
Seed at 1 Kg per acre. Call for \$/kg.

LANCE-LEAVED COREOPSIS *Coreopsis lanceolata* (Tall)

Easy to grow perennial! Quick to come up, blooms early and freely from summer until first fall frost. Shimmering, bright yellow sunburst. Drought tolerant and will take full sun. Foliage makes an attractive ground cover year round. For meadows, roadsides, mixtures and slopes.
Seed at 4.5 Kgs per acre. Call for \$/kg

PLAINS COREOPSIS *Coreopsis tinctoria* (Tall)

Annual. Prodigious bloomer spring to fall. Gorgeous, vibrant yellow flowers with maroon centers. Prefers full sun in various soil types. Ideal plant for poor drainage or soggy areas. For roadsides, ditches, low lying areas, mixtures.
Seed at 1 Kg per acre. Call for \$/kg

DWARF PLAINS COREOPSIS *Coreopsis tinctoria* (Dwarf)

Annual. Blooms spring to fall. A "gardener's delight". Vivid yellow and maroon flowers; feathery green foliage. Used to attract butterflies and birds. Excellent for soggy areas. Reseeds readily. Drought tolerant. For flower gardens, roadsides, mixtures, meadows, ditches.
Seed at 1 Kg per acre. Call for \$/kg

ROCKET LARKSPUR *Delphinium ajacis*

Annual. Blooms spring - summer. A delightful and easy to grow favorite! Set on backward projecting spikes with tightly compact blossoms in shades of pink, white, and deep blue. Prefers full sun to partial shade in very well-drained soils. For mixtures, roadsides, waste areas, floral gardens. CAUTION: Seeds and leaves poisonous if consumed.
Seed at 4.5 Kgs per acre. Call for \$/kg

FOXGLOVE *Digitalis purpurea*

Perennial. Blooms spring - summer. One of the loveliest plant species. On a tall spike, numerous purple flowers have obvious creamy spots interlining the flower's tubular throat. Prefers partial sun to full shade. For mixtures, roadsides, waste areas, floral gardens. CAUTION: DO NOT EAT. Extremely poisonous.
Seed at 0.25 Kgs per acre. Call for \$/kg

PURPLE CONEFLOWER *Echinacea purpurea*

Perennial. Blooms spring to fall. Absolutely stellar! Drought tolerant and robust, the soft lavender-purplish petals surround an "iris" of iridescent red-orange. Sturdy, elongated stems. Prefers full sun to partial shade in fertile, well-drained soils. Excellent cutting flower! For borders, meadows, mixtures, gardens.
Seed at 5.5 Kgs per acre. Call for \$/kg

CALIFORNIA POPPY *Eschscholzia californica*

Beautiful, bright orange perennial, blooms spring - summer. Lovely, hardy, and prolific. Silky, saucer shaped flowers. Prefers full sun in light to sandy soils. Extremely drought tolerant, ideal for arid environments. When planted en masse, the effect is breathtaking! For borders, rock gardens, meadows, mixes.
Seed at 4 Kgs per acre. Call for \$/kg

BLANKETFLOWER *Gaillardia aristata*

A gorgeous, hardy, drought tolerant perennial. Easily started from seed, it will form dense colonies of bright red flowers with ragged, butter yellow tips. Thrives in full sun in well-drained areas. Vase life of 6-10 days. For roadsides, drainage ditch slopes, open fields, mixes.
Seed at 4.5 Kgs per acre. Call for \$/kg

DAME'S ROCKET *Hesperis matronalis*

A hardy perennial with charming mauve flowers. While in bloom (spring - summer), it will fill each evening with its soft, sweet fragrance! Prefers well-drained soil in full sun or partial shade. Many blooms per plant. For borders along fences, roadsides, ditches, and meadows.
Seed at 4 Kgs per acre. Call for \$/kg

SCARLET FLAX *Linum rubrum*

Annual. The flowers are a glossy, deep scarlet, bloom in summer profusion and are really gorgeous planted en masse. Prefer full sun in well-drained soils. Once established, can tolerate immense heat, extremely dry conditions and require very little care. For mixtures, roadsides, meadows, and flower gardens.
Seed at 3.5 Kgs per acre. Call for \$/kg

BLUE FLAX *Linum lewisii*

Perennial, blue cup-shaped flowers bloom well into the summer. Prefers dry, full sun areas in light sandy soil. Flowers last only a single day but because they bloom in such astonishing profusion, this does not detract from their beauty. For flower gardens, mixtures, open fields, meadows.
Seed at 4 Kgs per acre. Call for \$/kg

PERENNIAL LUPINE *Lupinus perennis*

A hardy perennial, blooms spring - summer. Flowers sit on upright spikes and vary in shades from deep blue thru purple. Requires a dry, well-drained sandy or gravelly soil in full sun, so very popular for roadside seeding. Adaptable and versatile. For mixtures, roadsides, meadows, flower arrangements.
Seed at 15 Kgs per acre. Call for \$/kg

RUSSELL LUPINE *Lupinus polyphyllus*

A truly beautiful, mixed colour (shades of pink thru purple) perennial. Blooms in spring and smells like honey - bumblebees love them! Very dramatic when planted en masse, but also lovely scattered. For roadsides, mixtures, meadows.
Seed at 15 Kgs per acre. Call for \$/kg

EVENING PRIMROSE *Oenothera lamarckiana*

A robust annual, blooms spring - fall. Butter yellow flowers open in late afternoon and sit atop tall, secure spikes. Prefers well-drained soil in full sun. Prolific reseed. For roadsides, meadows, fence lines.
Seed at 1.5 Kgs per acre. Call for \$/kg

CORN POPPY *Papaver rhoeas*

A hardy annual, blooms spring thru summer. Bright red, 3-4" blossoms sit atop

erect hairy stems. Prefers well drained soil in full sun to partial shade. Visible from great distances; guaranteed to incite your neighbors' envy! For cutting gardens, roadsides, meadows.
Seed at 1 Kg per acre. Call for \$/kg

CALIFORNIA BLUEBELLS *Phacelia campanularia*

A hardy annual that's well adapted to arid environments. The bell-shaped flowers are a stunning deep blue with long, golden stamens. Prefers full sun in very sandy or well-drained soils. Most striking when sown en masse. Flowers last 3-4 weeks. For mixes, borders and containers.
Seed at 1.5 Kg per acre. Call for \$/kg

BLACK-EYED SUSAN *Rudbeckia hirta*

A stiff, upright perennial with rich orange/yellow, 2-4 inch "ray-type" florets surrounding a dark brown domed centre. Blooms for at least 60 days! Worships the sun and thrives in most soils. When cut, has a vase life of 6-10 days. For open fields, roadsides, cutting gardens.
Seed at 1 Kg per acre. Call for \$/kg

CATCHFLY *Silene armeria*

An attractive annual-biennial; blooms spring - fall. Rose-pink blooms grow in dense clusters radiating from a slender stem. Thrives in full sun or partial shade in various soils. For gardens, roadsides, disturbed areas.
Seed at 0.5 Kg per acre. Call for \$/kg

Meadow★Star Planting Instructions

Seed is best sown between the beginning of March and the end of May or the beginning of October and the middle of November. In warm wintered climates, seed sown in the fall will germinate in two to four weeks. In cold wintered climates, seed sown in the fall will lie dormant and germinate in the spring. Seed may be sown in the spring in either climate, however, supplemental irrigation may be required in some locations. If hydroseeding, double the seeding rate.

FERTILIZATION

Once a site has been selected, fertilizer should not normally be applied. The best results are usually achieved in soils of low fertility where the nitrogen status is low. Top soil often poses two disadvantages; it is usually fertile and it contains a large reserve of dormant weed seed. Tillage involved in seed bed preparation and the spreading of top soil provides the stimulus for the germination of many weed seeds which will compete and threaten the survival of the wildflowers.

WEED CONTROL

Early site preparation three to four weeks prior to sowing will provide an opportunity to eliminate early germinating annual weeds which usually emerge following tillage. Repeated cultivation may be required to kill

off persistent perennial weeds. Hand pull all weeds as soon as you can and on an on-going basis to get the best wildflower display.

SOIL PREPARATION

Prepare the site by working up the soil to create a fine, firm seed bed. Seed hand-sown should be carefully raked in but buried no deeper than one-eighth inch. On large areas, seed can be drilled to a maximum depth of one-quarter inch, mechanically seeded or hydroseeded with a mulching fiber. If drill or mechanically seeded, firm the soil with a culti-packer or roller to ensure seed is in firm contact with soil moisture. Good seed to soil contact encourages more rapid germination. If hydroseeding, seed wildflowers and 25% of mulch on the first pass, then seed the balance of mulch on the second pass.

GERMINATION PERIOD

Some seedlings appear in two weeks whereas others may take up to four weeks. Wildflower seed requires ample moisture to germinate. Best results are achieved when the seed bed is kept moist for four to six weeks. In non-irrigated areas, plant in anticipation of the seasonal rains. Up to ½ inch of supplemental water per week may be required to maintain an optimal display.

USE OF GRASSES

Wildflowers grow best when planted alone or with a non-aggressive bunch grass such as Sheep Fescue. The fescue will grow quickly

and provide soil stabilization. Aggressive grasses such as Annual Rye and Orchardgrass are not recommended because they will grow too quickly and gain ascendancy over the wildflowers.

LOW MAINTENANCE

Management of mature vegetation may consist of one mowing in the late fall when most species have finished flowering and set seed. The cuttings should be removed (leave all seed heads on site) to eliminate an accumulation of unsightly stems and leaf litter. Supplemental irrigation may be required in dry seasons to prolong blooming.
